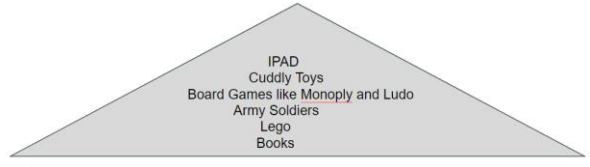

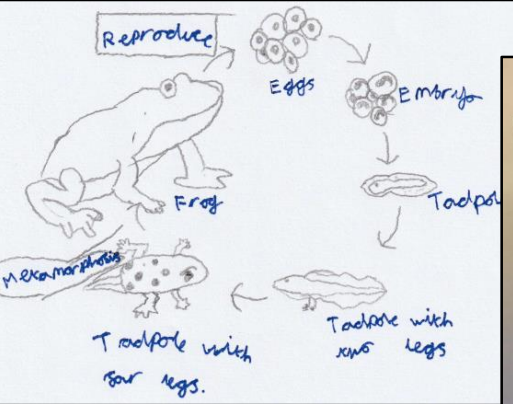
Flagellants

They started traing at 7 and became a Knight at 21. They followed a behaviour code called Chivry. They had to honour women and defend the church and King. Each Knight had their own coat of arms.

Coats of Arms
 A coat of arms is how Knights in battle knew who each other and what Knight was. Different families had a different coat of arms. If a family had the same one as another family a court called the high court of chivalry they would decide who got to keep it.
 At the bottom there is a motto and at the sides there were animals called stance. The look like their holding it up. At the top there were a helmet. For people to have a coat of arms they would have had to be given to them or passed down through their family.
