Winter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • White polo shirt with school logo - <i>additional polo shirts can be plain white</i> • Navy, round neck sweatshirt with school logo • Dark grey (charcoal) school trousers or skirt • Grey or black socks/tights • KS1 Book Bag - navy with school logo
Summer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Same as the winter uniform with following optional items: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ dark grey (charcoal) school shorts ➢ blue/white checked (gingham) summer dress
KS2 (Year 3 - Year 6)	
Winter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • White shirt - <i>long or short sleeve</i> • Navy, V neck sweatshirt with school logo • Manorcroft striped tie • Dark grey (charcoal) school trousers or skirt • Grey or black socks/tights
Summer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Same as the winter uniform with following optional items: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ dark grey (charcoal) school shorts ➢ blue/white checked (gingham) summer dress
PE KIT (Year R - Year 6)	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy PE shirt with school logo • Plain navy or navy shadow stripe shorts • Tracksuit or jogging bottoms/sweatshirt - <i>preferably in dark, plain colour</i> • Trainers • Drawstring PE Bag - navy with school logo

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	
Shoes:	Sensible, flat black shoes must be worn at all times. Trainers, ankle boots, strappy or open toed shoes are not allowed.
Coats:	All children need a coat in cold or wet weather. An optional reversible jacket is available to buy.
KS2 Bags:	An optional school backpack is available. If children choose to bring their own bag, it must be small and sturdy.
Jewellery:	Jewellery is not allowed. If earrings are worn, then they must be small, plain silver/gold studs. Children must be able to remove them independently for all PE lessons.
Make Up:	Make up, including nail varnish, is not allowed.
Watches:	If watches are worn, children must be responsible for them. Please do not send expensive smart watches to school.
Hair:	Sensible and appropriate haircuts are required for school. No extreme haircuts or styles, or excessive gel/wax, are allowed. Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back; any hair accessories should be small and plain (preferably navy).
