Phonics Screening Check (PSC)

The Phonics Screening Check is a test carried out towards the end of Y1 where children have to score a minimum of 32/40 in order to meet the threshold. If children do not meet the threshold in Y1 then they are given another opportunity to re-take the test in Y2.
