- Read a version of the story Little Red Riding Hood. Talk about how Red Riding Hood describes the wolf. Draw a picture of the wolf and add labels.
- Share the story of the Three Little Pigs. Design a new house for the pigs or make one out of building bricks and take a picture to upload to Tapestry.
- Share the story of The Three Billy Goats Gruff. Draw a map to show where the characters from the story live. Retell the story using the map. You could record a video of you retelling the story and upload it to Tapestry.
- A long time ago, kings and queens made rules for the country. If you were the king or queen, what rules would you make?
- Count out 20x1p coins. Put the coins in a row. Take it in turns to take up to three coins at a time. The object of the game is to collect the last coin. It doesn't matter how many coins you have at the end of the game. Play the game more than once.
- Talk about different fairy tale characters and decide whether they are goodies or baddies. Then, draw a picture of some goodies or baddies.
- Draw a picture or make a mask or puppet of your favourite fairy tale character. Can you explain why this character is your favourite? Upload your work to Tapestry.
- Can you tell your grown up which fairy story is your favourite? Why is this your favourite story?
