

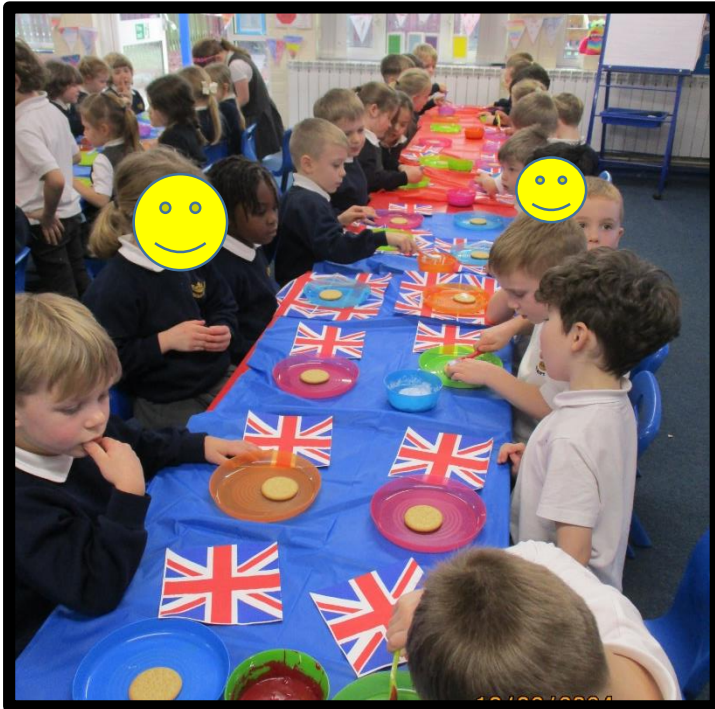

It is a giant Ferris wheel

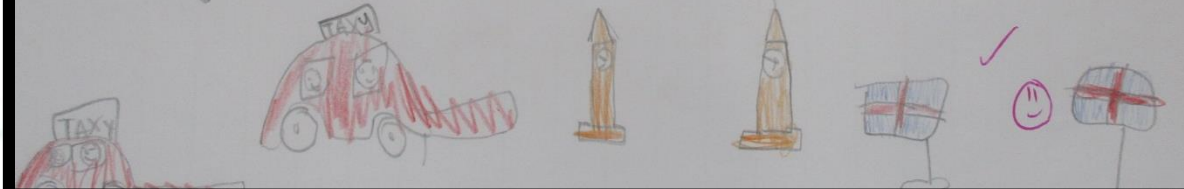
and it reaches up so high

We're on a trip in London.

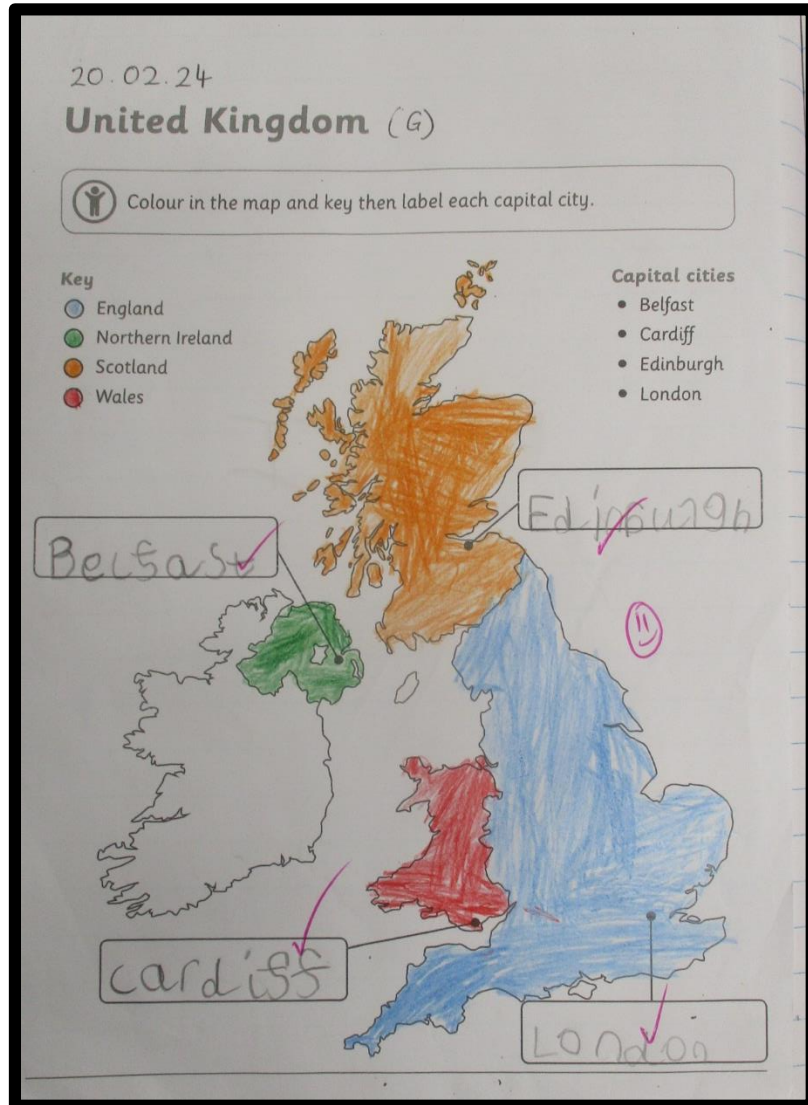
We're looking at Big Ben

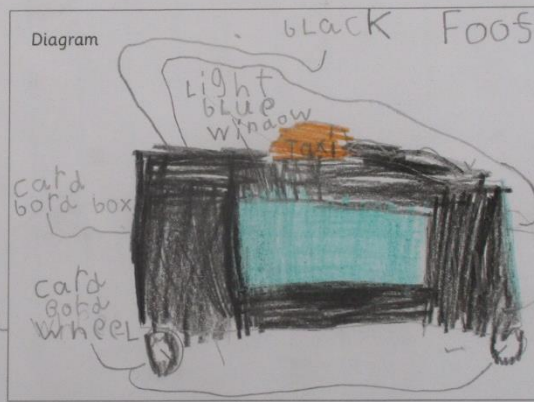
