


Royal Tea Party

tea party!










English: Famous London Landmarks


Geography: The United Kingdom




We learned about the four countries which make up the United Kingdom and labelled them on a map.

In DT, we made moving vehicles. First we investigated and evaluated different ways to make a working wheel and axle mechanism.








DT: Taxis and double decker buses!
