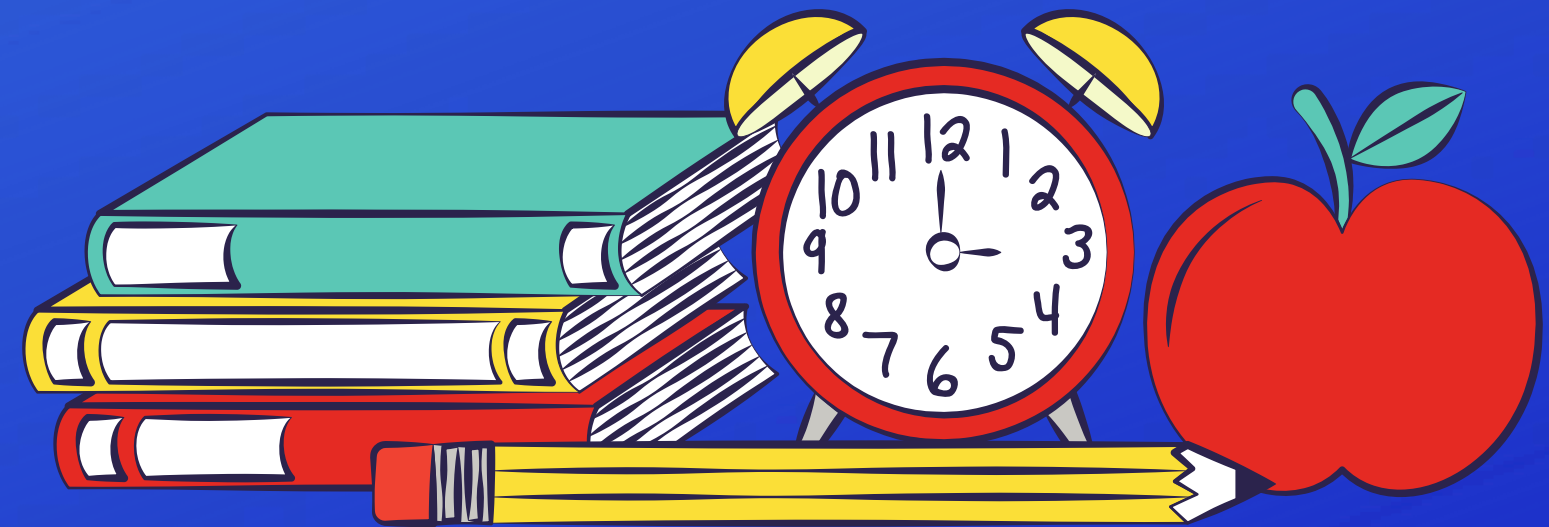

# English – Reading

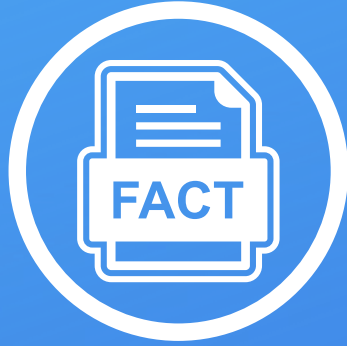
# Phonics



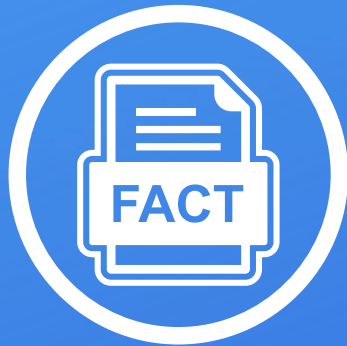
- Daily whole class phonics sessions
- Group reading practice sessions - 3 times a week
- Fluency/Prosody/Comprehension
- Fully decodable books- read at 95% fluency
- Keep up sessions- no child is left behind
- Consistent resources



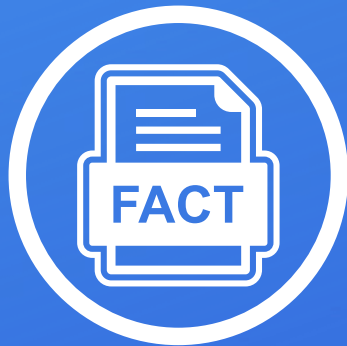
# English – Reading



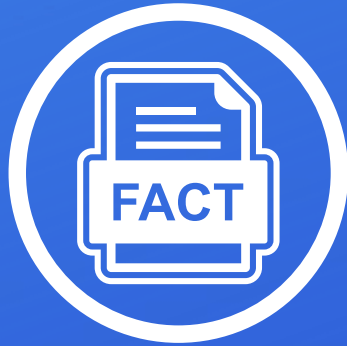
Reading enjoyment has been reported as more important for children's educational success than their family's socio-economic status.



Regularly reading stories or novels outside of school is associated with higher scores in reading assessments.



Reading for pleasure can improve general knowledge and help with other subject areas.



Reading for pleasure has emotional benefits.



- **We want every child to read every night.**
- **10 –15 minutes**
- **It can be a mixture of reading activities – child reading, adult reading to the child, listening to an audiobook, reading a comic etc.**
- **Record in Weekly diary**

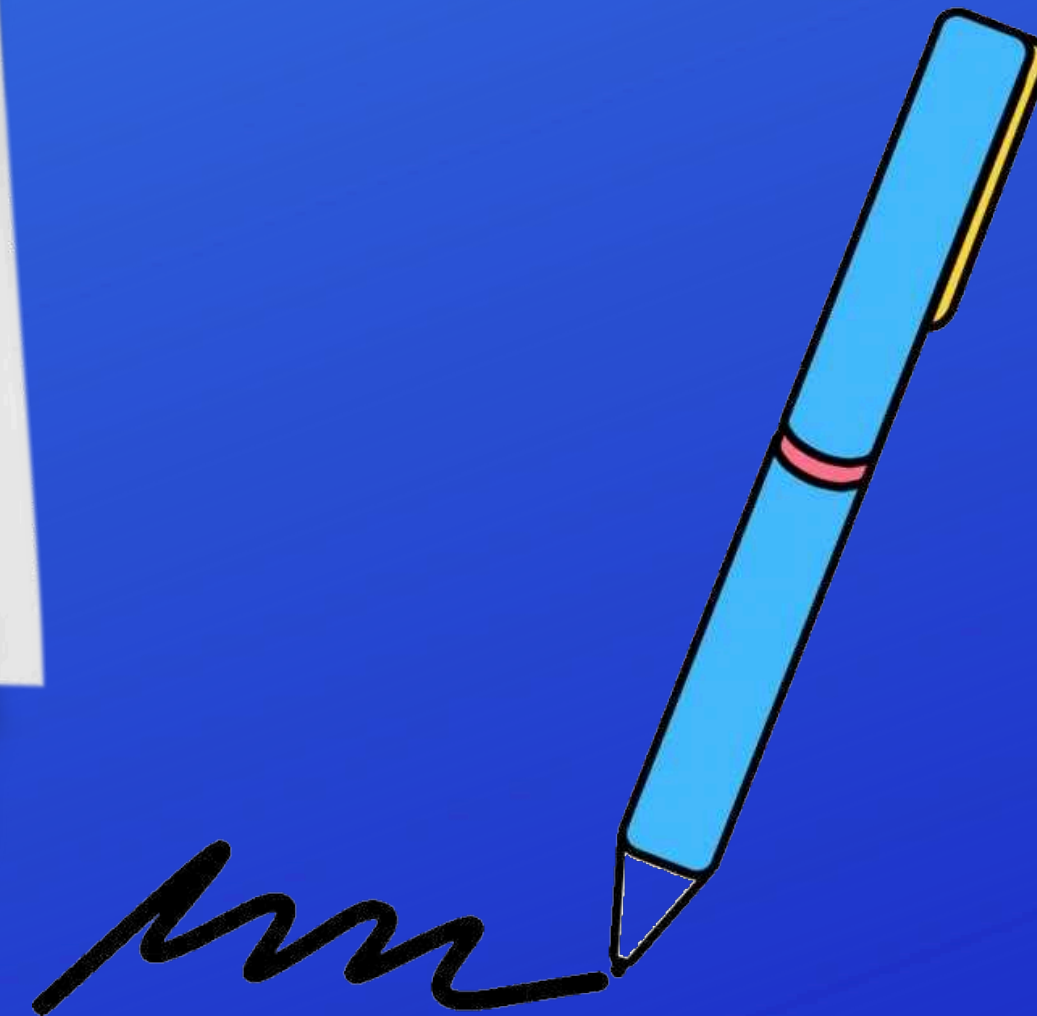

- Practice writing at home - labelling pictures, adding captions and sentences

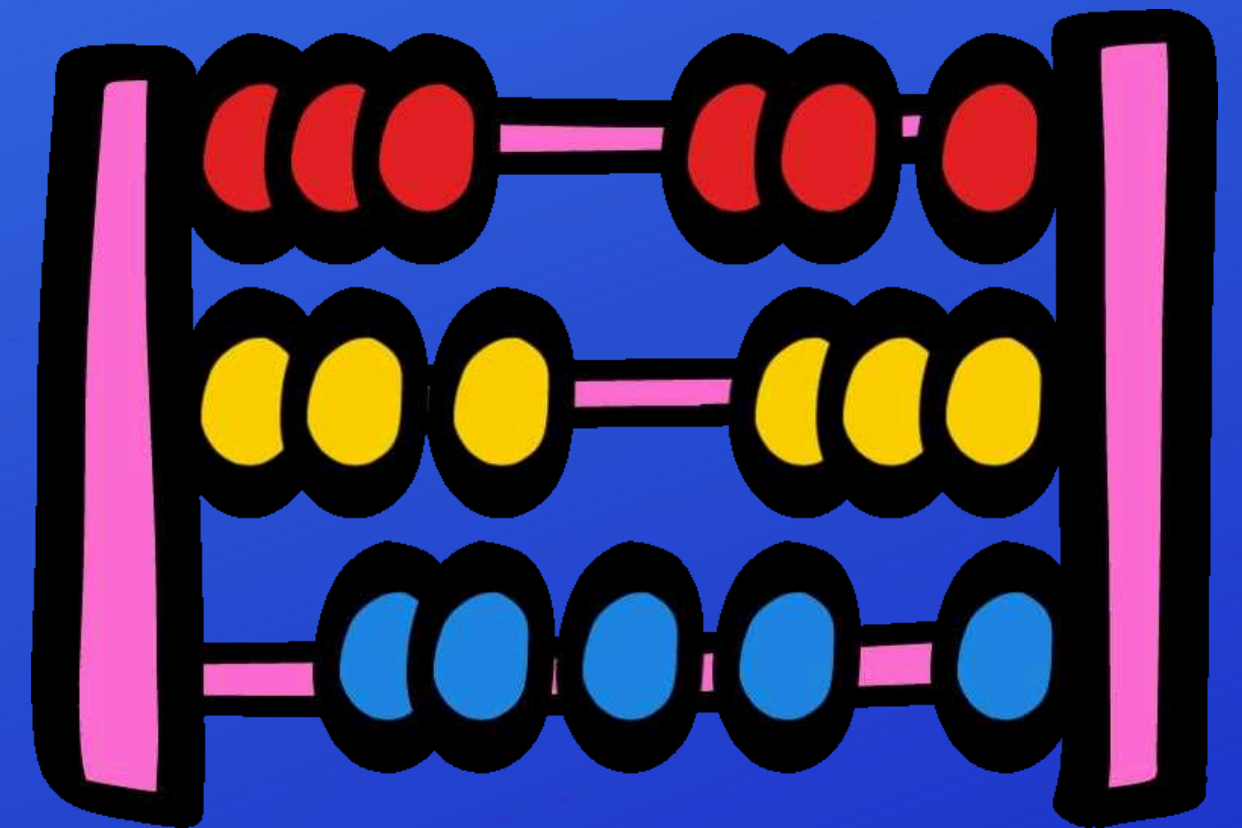
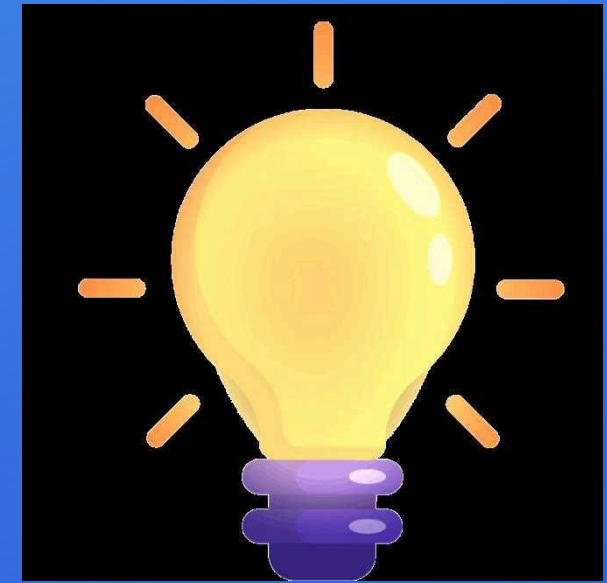
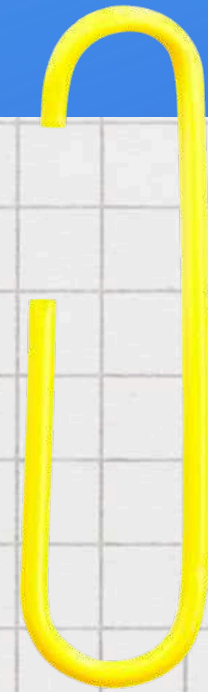


# Maths

- Problem Solving

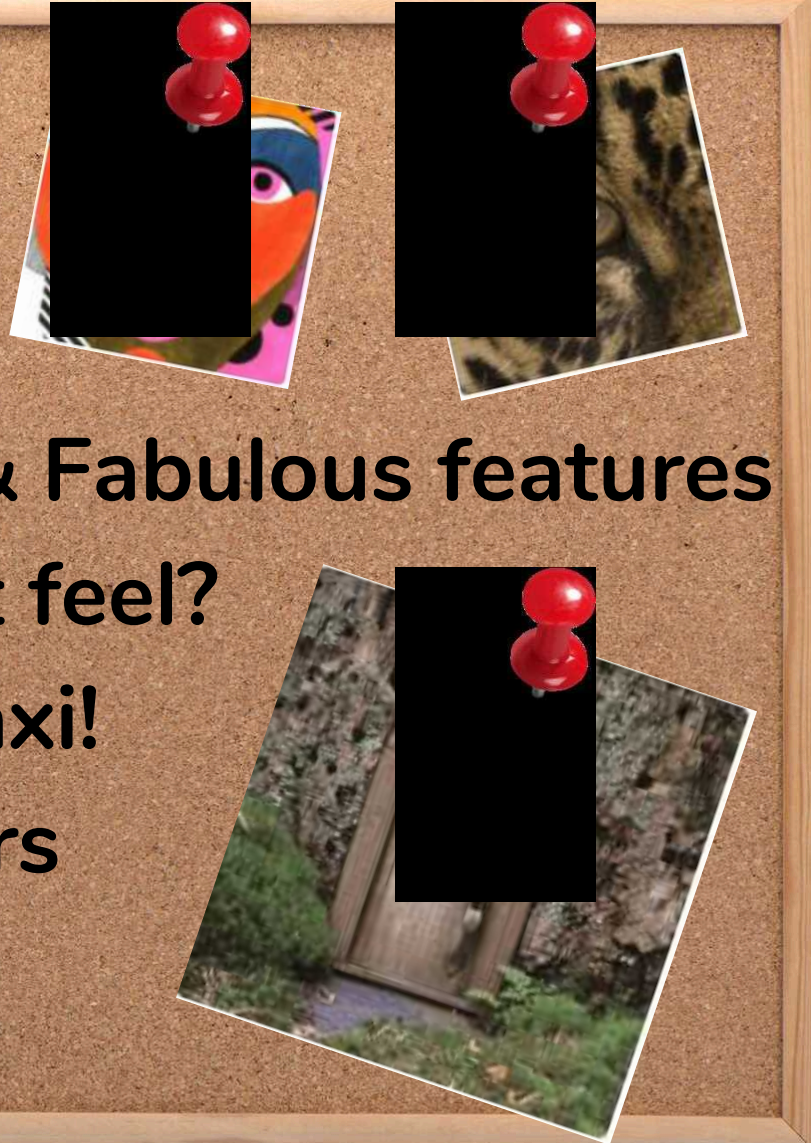
Maths home learning each week - MyMaths or written task.

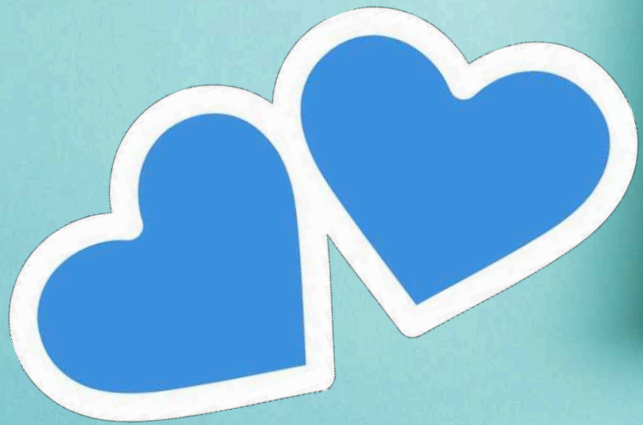
