Open Mornings - We have now completed a run of 6 Open Mornings for parents considering Manorcroft for the September YR 2026 intake. A special mention to our Class Ambassadors across the school who have done an amazing job of talking to all our visitors and explaining a little more about the learning in all the classrooms. The deadline date for all YR admissions for 2026 is 15th January 2026. A reminder that if your child attends Manorcroft Nursery, there is no affiliation and you must still complete the admission form.

Parking - Parking around the school site is incredibly tricky. In order to help with the situation, we need all parents and carers who drive at drop-off and pick-up to support us.

Please do not:

- Drive recklessly
- Speed
- Block the roundabout near the Nursery pedestrian gate
- Park illegally, including blocking the driveways of local residents and parking on the zigzag lines
- Park in Egham Bowls Club - this is private property and has an ANPR system in operation

Please do:

- Keep the slip road up to the main school gates completely clear at all times - it is narrow and is used as a pedestrian walkway

We have an agreement in place with Egham Orbit Sports Centre, who will allow parents to park in their car park at school drop-off and pick-up times, meaning that you can walk very quickly through to the school gates. Please can we ask that parents use this facility. The local police and Runnymede Borough Council are aware of the parking situation and regularly support the school.

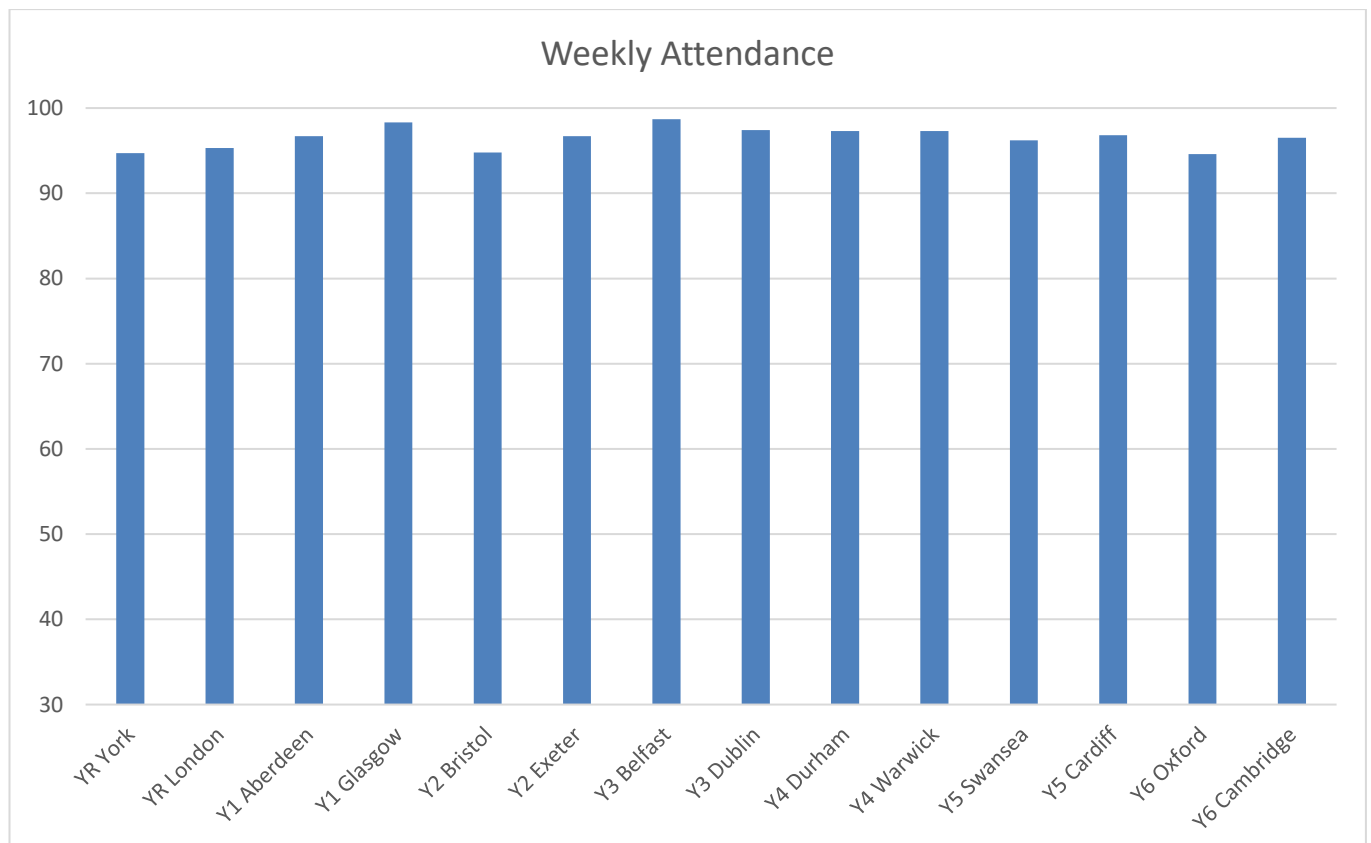
