Y4 Water Workshop - On Monday we were visited by Affinity Water who led their 'Water Smart' workshops for our Y4 children. The sessions were great fun as they were all hands-on using LEGO robotics kits, with an important real-world mission: protecting our water supply. A huge thank you to Affinity Water as the workshops were fully funded for the children.

Y5 Fire Safety Workshops - Yesterday we welcomed Julie Newth from Surrey Fire and Rescue. She spent time in Y5 talking to the children about fire safety, in particular, focusing on safety in the home. The children thoroughly enjoyed the sessions and we look forward to welcoming her back next week to work with our Y2 children.

New Reading Resources - We've been very fortunate to receive another grant from the 'Strode's Foundation' which we've been able to put towards new reading resources in school. The money has allowed us to buy some better storage for our 'Gem Readers', meaning each year group now has easily accessible resources. In addition, we've been able to purchase over 1000 new titles to increase the Gem Reader selection across the school. The Strode's Foundation is a local charity which arose from the will of Henry Strode, back in 1704. This is the second time the foundation have supported the school, and in total we have received £14,000 towards our reading curriculum.

New Fencing - We've recently had new fencing installed around the YR, Y1, Y2 and Y5 outside areas. The original wooden fencing had become rotten and was no longer fit for purpose. This investment has smartened up the outside areas considerably. The next plan is to build new footpaths for the Y2 and Y5 fire doors. Watch this space!

Pick-Up - Thank you for bearing with us on Wednesday at pick-up. When we get heavy rainfall at school our back playgrounds and visitor car park do not cope very well, meaning that we get localised flooding. Hence why the pick-up route was changed for parents. No doubt this won't be the last time this will happen this term!

Golden Wellies Award - There has been a huge need to wear wellie boots this week at lunchtime given the very damp weather. A big shout out to Xander in Y3, who has single handedly taken it upon himself to make sure all the wellies across the school are sorted at the end of lunch, and back in the correct place. 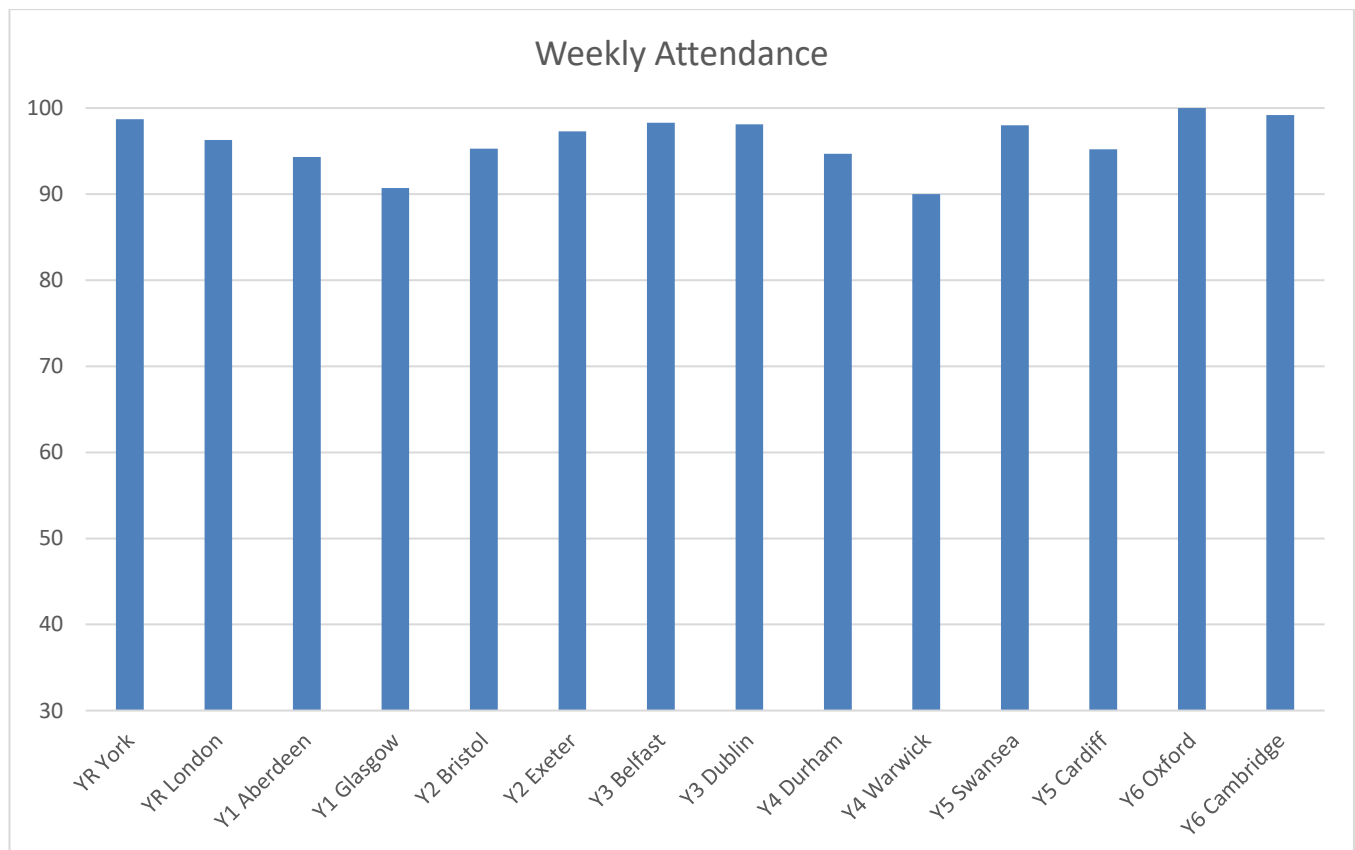
