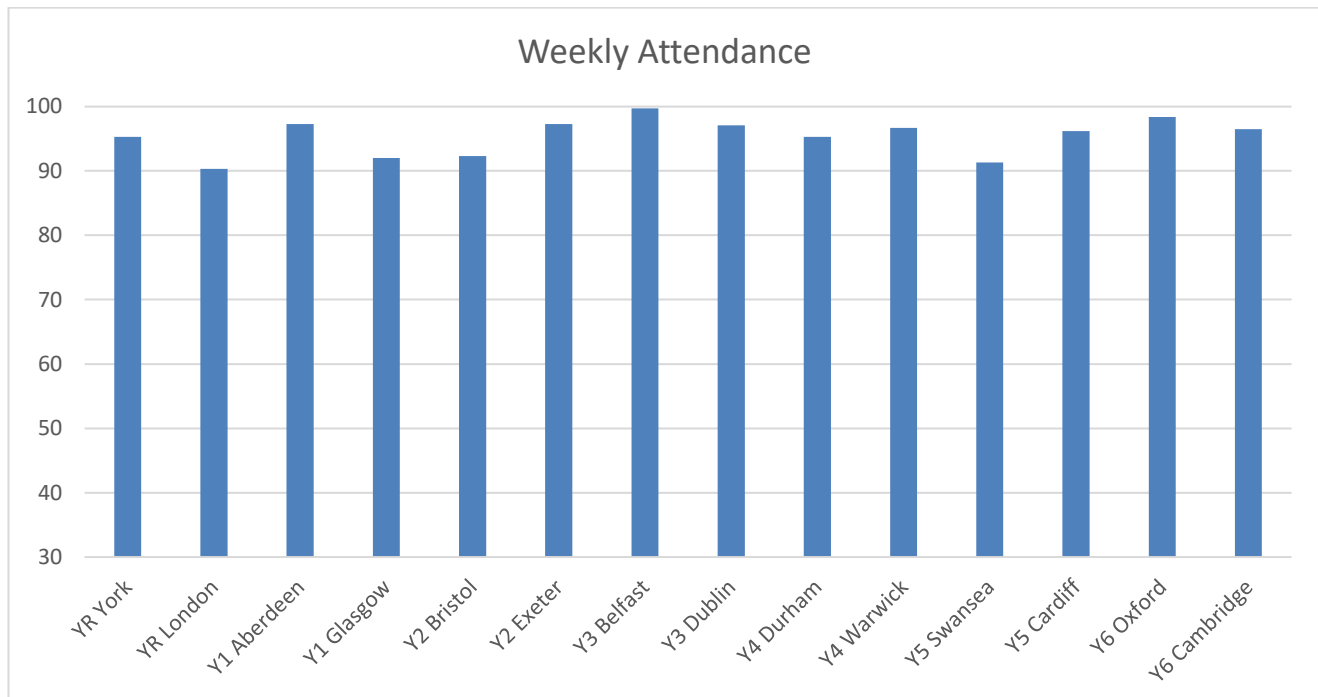

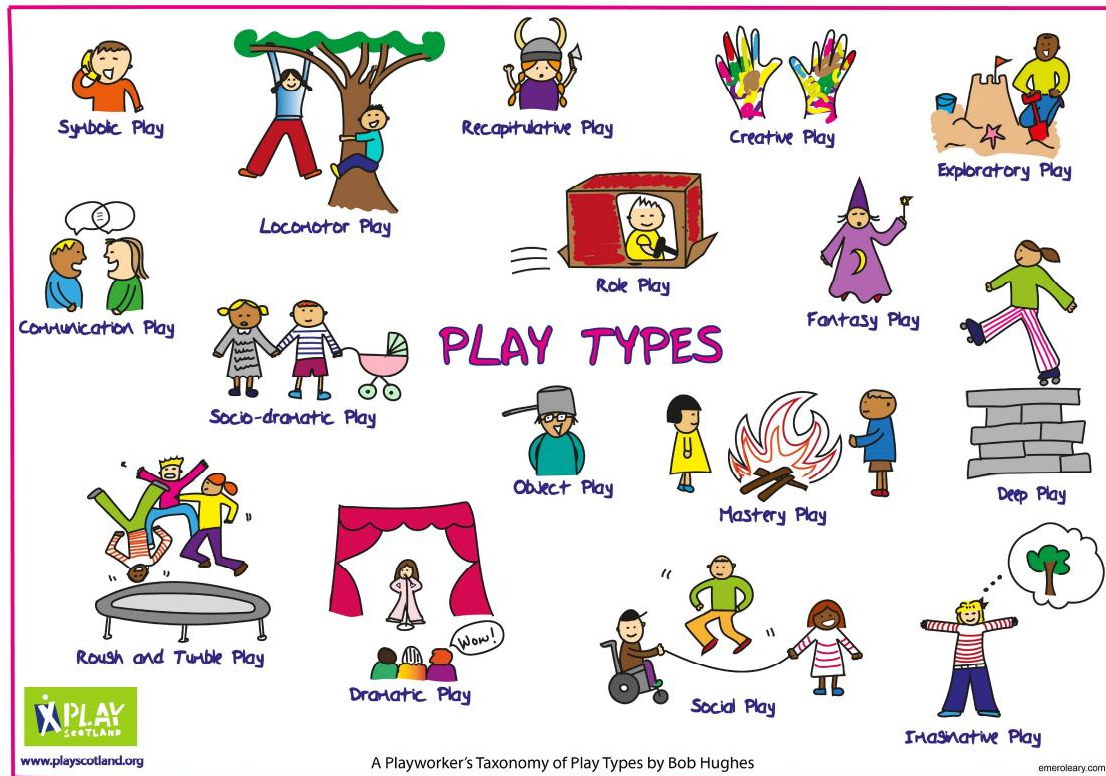
The Attendance Cup this week goes to: **Y3 Belfast** with **99.7%**
