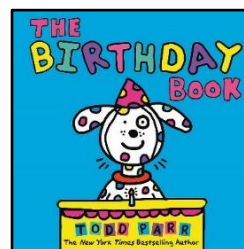
Autumn Term 2026, Week 3

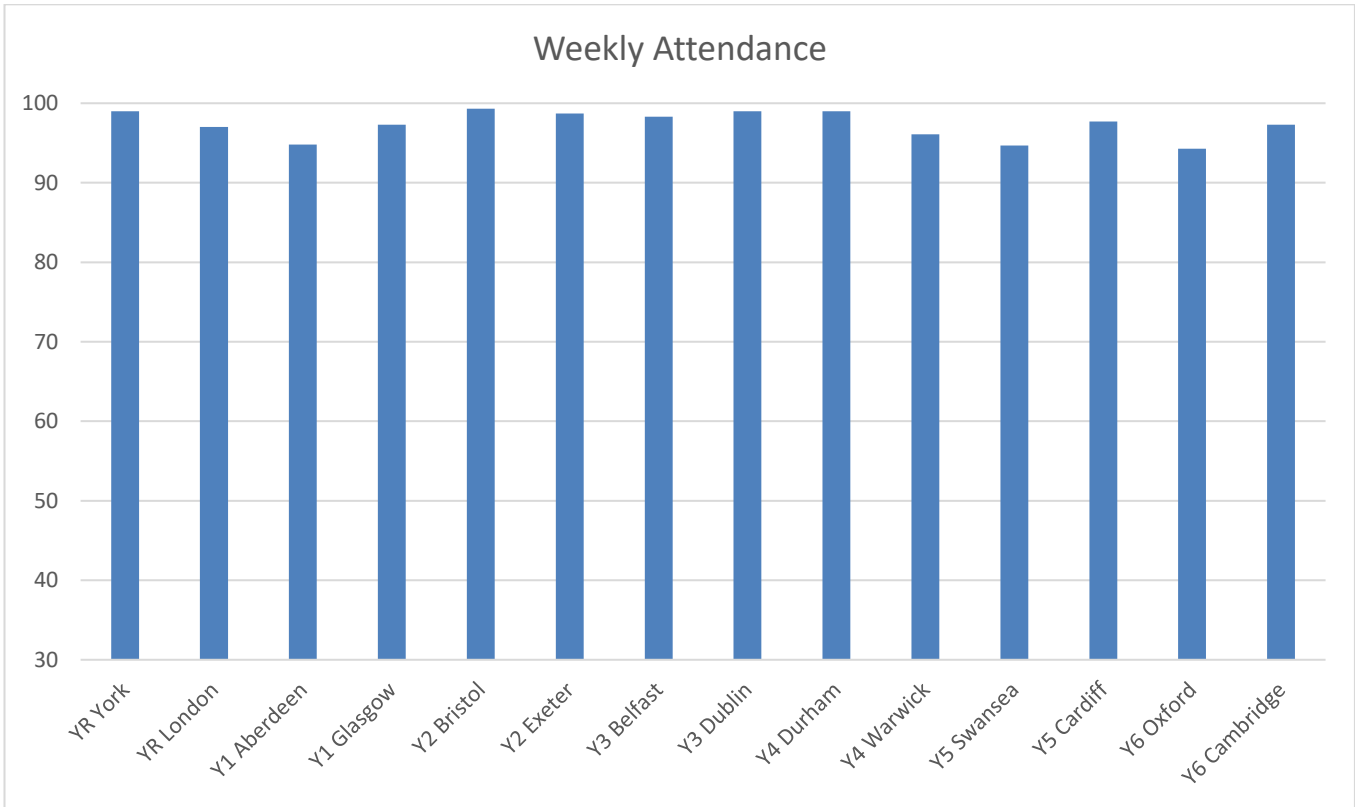
